PROHIBITION ORDER

UPON the laying of an information by the Attorney General of Canada alleging violation of sections 52(1)(a) and (d) of the *Competition Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c C-34, as amended, (the "*Act*");

AND UPON the parties agreeing to the issuance of a Prohibition Order pursuant to section 34(2) of the *Act*;

AND UPON determination that it appears that Gireesh Athavale is about to or is likely to do any act or thing constituting or directed toward the commission of an offence under section 52(1)(a) or (d) of the *Act*;

1. **THIS COURT DOES PROHIBIT** the Respondent, Gireesh Athavale, from:
 - a) making any representations to the public relating to the sale of jewellery which misrepresents the value of the jewellery; and

b) making any misleading representations as to the regular selling price of jewellery and the relative savings to consumers on the products being offered for sale.

2. **AND THIS COURT SHALL** retain jurisdiction over the parties to this proceeding for the purposes of interpreting, varying or rescinding any of the provisions of this Order, upon the application of either party.

3. This Order shall be in effect for a period of ten years.
