

INDICTMENT

THE ACCUSED stands charged:


1. THAT FREYSSINET LIMITÉE (carrying on business *inter alia*, as a party to the FREYSSINET-LUNDRIGANS joint venture which itself was a party to the FREYSSINET-DSI joint venture), on or about the 9th day of January, 1992, at or near the City of St. John's, in the Province of Newfoundland did, in response to a call or request for tenders issued by Newfoundland Offshore Development Constructors (NODECO) for a contract for the supply and installation of the Prestressing Steel System for Phase I of the Gravity Base Structure construction for the Hibernia Development project located at Grand Banks, Atlantic Ocean - 46 degrees 45' 1.5722" north, 48 degrees, 46'58.5427" west, submit a tender that was the subject of an agreement or arrangement with VSL Corporation (carrying on business through its wholly-owned subsidiary International Construction Systems, Inc. as a party to the joint venture Newfoundland Prestressing Joint Venture), where the agreement or arrangement was not made known to NODECO at or before the time when any tender was made by any person who was a party to the agreement or arrangement contrary to s. 47 of the *Competition Act*, R.S., 1985, c. C-34, committing thereby an indictable offence under section 47(2) of the said Act.
